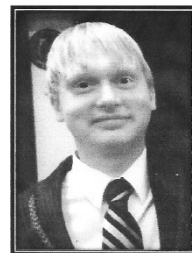

Memorial Day Parade

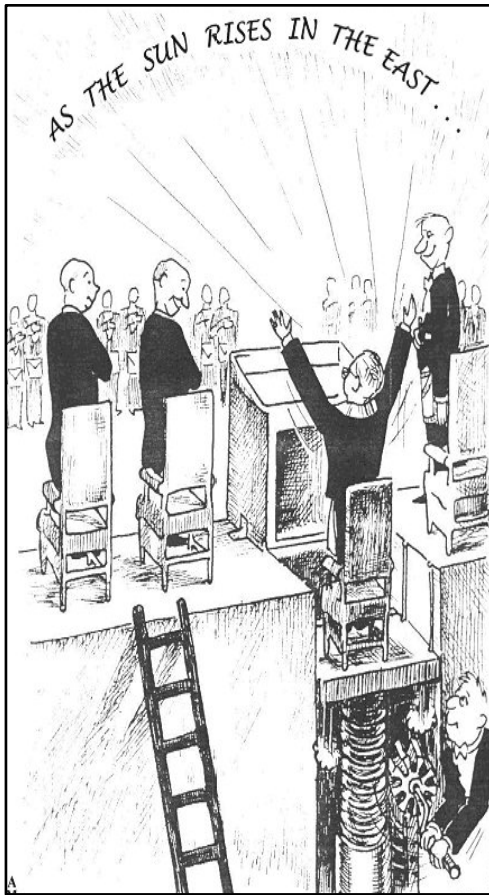
